


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

Now You have Your own HACKED TOY!


How to select a good toy:

1). Try to find a toy at home.


(one not used any more)




2). Go to a Second hand or dollar store to find a toy.




Does your toy make sound?




NO Sound?

OPEN THE TOY with a screwdriver.




Removing a Screw




Inserting a Screw




How does your toy make a sound?







Batteries are power! [I'm a Circuit board.]




How do they work together?




They are a sound making team -KEEP THEM Together!






Touch the other end of the wire to any other Part of the Circuit board.




Did the sound change?


15 NOT, touch the wire to another Part of the circuit board and Listen!



Make sure that you are doing this when the toy is making a sound!









Put the clips on the Sound Changing Places on the board.

Push the Button!




Try Potentio--meter and light sensor!

How to add a Light Sensor




More electricity thavels throught the light sensor when there is <u>light</u>.




